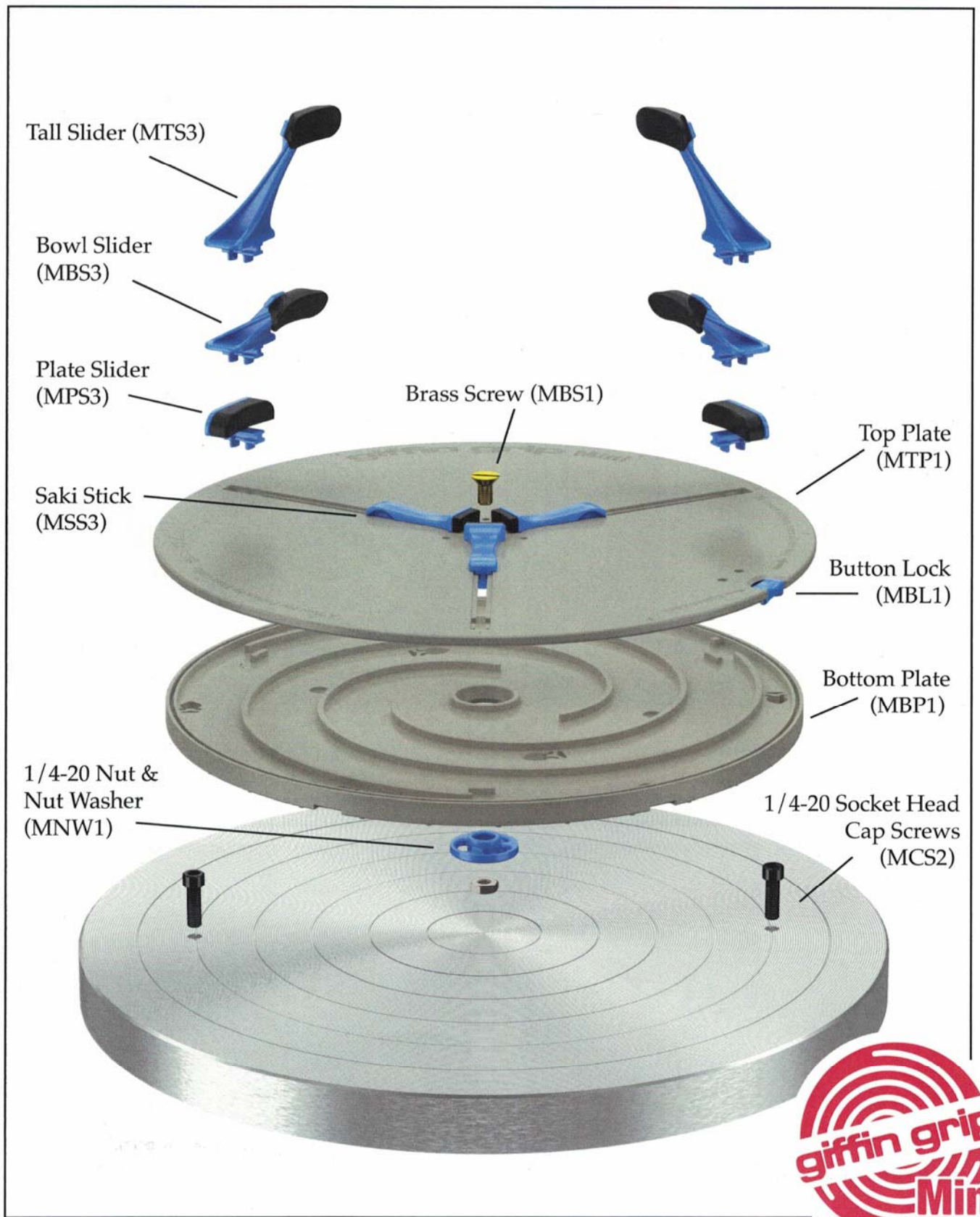

# Anleitung Giffin Gripp MINI

1



Locate the fish shapes

2



Align the fish with the bat pins

3



Press downward evenly

4



Turn all the way to the left

5



Drop in the sliders

6



Turn right to move sliders inward

Place your pot close to center

8



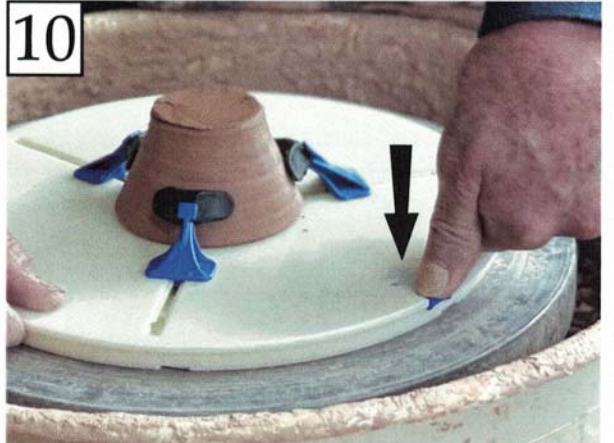
Tighten the chuck

Give it a wiggle and tighten again

10



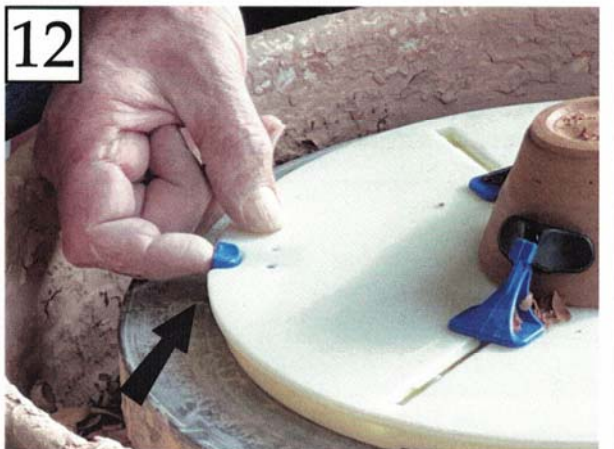
Press the blue button to lock

Trim with confidence

# Anleitung Giffin Gripp MINI

## Saki Sticks



The Saki Sticks allow you to trim even tiny pots like sake cups! With a low profile and a min. diameter of 5/8" (16mm) there is almost no vessel too small to trim with the Giffin Grip Mini.

## Plate Sliders



The Plate Sliders have a wide profile so you can utilize the full width of the Giffin Grip Mini. Maximum diameter of 9 1/2 inches (240mm)

## Bowl Sliders



The Bowl Sliders are designed for bowls of varying size. At 1" or (25mm) tall they are high enough to clear the lip of the bowl, yet low enough to allow for trimming much of the vessel.

## Tall Sliders



The Tall Sliders are designed to hold tall pots that require a higher support position. The hands are 2.5" high or (64mm), and are for tall cups, mugs, goblets and vases.



To lock press button down firmly. It clicks only when released.

**Maintenance** - The Giffin Grip Mini has tight tolerances. It works best when cleaned regularly.

**Cleaning** - Use a flat head screwdriver or a coin to unscrew the brass screw. Pull the two plates apart and clean off any clay.

**Tightening** - When reassembling the Giffin Grip Mini, tighten the brass screw all the way and then back off 1/3rd turn for proper tension.

**Dish Soap Lubrication** - Clean with very soapy warm water. Drip dry without rinsing, for smooth operation.

**Bat Pins** - Many people prefer throwing with the bat held on a ring of clay. If you don't have bat pins in your wheel, these are for you. If your wheel already has pins... now you have two more!

To install, first clean the clay out of the holes. Next, drop the 1/4-20 bat pins in. Then place the Giffin Grip® Mini onto the pins and you're ready to trim!

Remove the pins when finished.
